As I shared at our Easter Celebration, one of the lines that stood out for me in the Easter Play was “We don’t have to travel across history to find God – He comes looking for us in the Person of Jesus – His love and forgiveness goes **across all generations** ...”

This is relevant to us in a number of ways. The fact that CRIBS has been in schools for over 30 years means that children, and potentially over the next few years grandchildren, of those impacted by CRIBS in their younger years are now also experiencing CRIBS in schools! **The message hasn’t changed** as we still seek to share the **Good News** of the light, love and life of Jesus with children and young people through all the different activities that we undertake with schools.

One of our ambassadors has shared her testimony with us of the impact of CRIBS when she was at school and it’s wonderful that she is now actively representing and advocating the work of CRIBS. My own children have been able to see CRIBS in their primary schools and my son, who is now working and married, and has just become a father, is now a supporter of CRIBS.

Can I, therefore, **encourage you** in two ways... if you have children or grandchildren, maybe you could invite them to become CRIBS supporters, particularly if they have experienced CRIBS in their school life? If not family, then maybe you have friends who you can invite to become CRIBS supporters?

As we develop **generations of supporters** so we can help to ensure the continued ministry of CRIBS to this and future **generations of children** in our schools...



*In recent lessons with Year 4, children were asking great questions, such as “Why did Jesus die?”, “How did Jesus come back to life?”, “When was the Bible written?” and the questions keep coming...*

*Amusingly, when a Reception class was asked “What did God do on the 7th day of creation?” one reply was “He went to a ballet class...”*

Teaching Christianity in schools, sharing Bible truths with children, from the ages of 2 - 11 years, is a privilege that we don’t take lightly! Topics are taught over a number of weeks, allowing us to really unpack each subject.

Our time in school is also a good opportunity to connect with staff and, on occasions, be able to pray with them. In many schools we really feel part of their community.
